Annual Dues and Fees

Each December, the Board of Directors shall determine the classification of each membership, the financial status of each membership, the amount of and schedule of dues, fees and charges.

Membership dues any annual fees shall be established by the Board of Directors and shall be payable on or before January 31 of each year. Those members whose accounts are not paid within 60 days of that date will be considered delinquent and be brought to the attention of the Board of Directors.

The Club has no obligation to reimburse a member for any annual dues or fees, or any portion thereof during a period of suspension or upon termination or resignation of the membership. Members shall remain liable for all fees for charges incurred prior to the date of termination.

Payment of Accounts

Each member will be assigned an account number and will be responsible for providing the Club with a current billing address.

All accounts shall be paid in full within thirty days of statement date. If any member falls behind, a credit card must be put on file and all future charges will be put on that card. Delinquencies will be recorded by Club staff and reported to the Board of Directors for possible disciplinary action.

Members with accounts more than thirty days past due (i.e. sixty days beyond the statement date) will be subject to the following:

1st offense - Automatic suspension of Club privileges until the account is brought current

2nd offense - Club privileges will be terminated and the member must appear before the Board of Directors to request reinstatement. Reinstatement terms will be at the discretion of the Board.

Former members who have unpaid obligations are not welcome and cannot be a guest at the Club.

Termination and Suspension

The Board of Directors shall have the absolute right in its sole discretion to censure, suspend or terminate a membership of any member whenever;



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- A member, spouse or his/her family member is delinquent of any obligation owed to the Club as previously described above.
- A member, spouse, family member or his or her guest violates the rules and regulations of the Club. The Board of Directors may designate the length of time of the suspension and may establish such reasonable requirements as it deems appropriate as a condition of reinstatement of a member. Any member who has been suspended or terminated cannot be a guest at the Club.

Members resigning their membership must submit a written resignation to the Board of Directors for acceptance. All resignations received prior to January 31 of each fiscal year become effective as of January 1 of that fiscal year without any further obligation by the member to the Club.

Resignations received after January 31 of any fiscal year will become effective only as of December 31 of such fiscal year. Until such time as a resignation has been submitted, all members are responsible for the balance of any contracted for or authorized charges on their account subject to the terms and conditions set forth above.

In the event of highly unusual circumstances, such as unavoidable job relocation, a resigning member may request in writing special consideration of the deadline for submission of resignation. The Board of Directors reserves the right to grant an exception at its sole discretion.
